## As a Growing Market - The Potential of Turkey

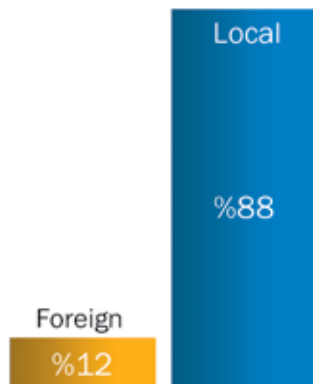
- \* GNP which was 230 billion USD in 2002 increased to 736 billion USD in 2010 – a rapidly developing economy
- \* As a result of the economic growth, industrialization and urbanization, there is increasing demand for environmental products and services in Turkey especially in the areas of waste management, water supply and management and air pollution management
- \* Potential annual biogas production capacity based on the existing livestock waste level is over 3 billion cubic meters.
- \* The main renewable energy resources of Turkey comprise hydraulic energy, wind energy, geothermal energy, biomass, waste and solar energy
- \* The total amount of investments to be made until 2023 to be able to meet the energy demand in Turkey, is expected to reach 130 billion USD
- \* The total amount of investments to be made until 2023 to be able to meet the EU Environmental criteria is expected to reach 58 billion Euro
- \* Turkey has the potential to become the biofuel transmission hub of Europe with its high potential for agricultural activities and established capacity for biodiesel and bioethanol products
- \* A total of 24,36 million tons per annum of municipal waste has been collected in Turkey.
- \* The total spending on environmental services was 4.382.079.255 TL in 2005 and it reached 8.377.129.879 in 2009
- \* Metropolitan Municipalities like Istanbul are looking for waste-to-energy solutions
- \* Ministry of Environment and Urbanization is supporting integrated waste management solutions.
- \* There are many on going projects and investments about waste water treatment and sanitary landfill which means solution for sludge and production of electricity are also potentials within the market
- \* Required and planned investment for solid waste management is around 9 billion Euro and for environment is 58 billion Euro in between 2007-2023

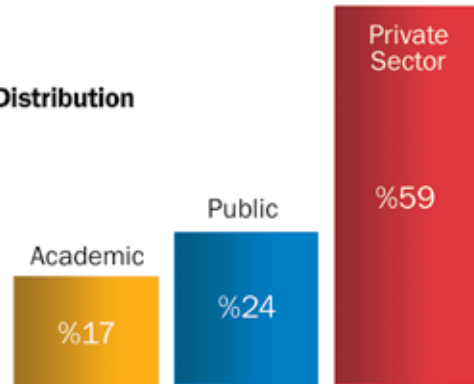
